

ADVANCING FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT IN NEW HAMPSHIRE

Introduction to Formative Assessment Video Study Groups

Teachers have the opportunity to continue working together to deepen classroom formative assessment. As ambassadors to student-focused assessment in New Hampshire, we heard strong interest in your continuing this work. As a result, NHLI has invited WestEd to build on the skills developed in formative assessment with Margaret Heritage. The focus of this year's work is centered on how **students use formative assessment** to learn how to monitor and support their own learning.

To date, over 500 teachers have engaged in Formative Assessment Video Study, and WestEd has gathered compelling evidence of changes in student and teacher practices. During the Video Study process, teachers set individual learning goals, based on their analysis of student use of core formative assessment practices. Teachers report that the Video Study tools help to deepen their focus on how students are learning, which has had a powerful impact on how they, themselves, learn.

Teachers participating in Video Study have reported gains in students' ability to set daily learning goals, use evidence to guide their own learning, accurately assess daily evidence of learning, and develop self-regulation skills. More recent reflections from teachers who have participated in Video Study over several years show the value of this work over time – with notable changes in how students engage in, and often show a preference for, learning from one another.
