

During the day, Lee Ann will facilitate thinking around Universal Design for Learning as a means to bring equity in learning experiences and outcomes for a broad range of student variability. The session will challenge the traditional views of general and special education as distinctly different and offer UDL as a way of bringing the voices from all faculty together for shared design of instruction. Lee Ann will guide participants to consider why choice in assessment is necessary and the many ways students can demonstrate their understanding. We explore these multiple means of expression within the context of construct validity--ensuring that we are measuring what we intend to measure. We generate solutions to these questions: What are confounding variables, and how do they compromise the validity of our assessments? Why are options for student expression important? How can we support our teams to provide students with options to show their learning in a way that improves, rather than compromises validity? How do we provide options and maintain a perception of fairness? How do we accomplish all of this with efficiency, rather than an additional burden on teachers?
