How Did We Do and Where Do We Go from Here?

Reflection is critical for all learners. This session will allow building leaders to participate in a guided reflective process to determine next steps by leveraging relative areas of strength as well as identifying key opportunities for growth. Participants will explore structures to enhance their collaborative approach to meeting the needs of all students in their school, and consider and plan for effective communication to stakeholders.
